



Olivewood Gardens and Learning Center is entering our second decade of inspiring youth and adults to be healthy and active citizens through education, access, and advocacy championing health equity. In 11 years, we have had over 100,000 visitors to our garden.

- We serve up to 1700+ students annually through our Children's Garden and Nutrition Education program,
- Engage high school volunteers and interns through our three youth leadership programs,
- Lead adults through multi-week transformational cooking, nutrition, and community building programs, and
- Support over 275 'Kitchenista®' graduates in the community many of whom participate in our monthly programs to continue their leadership and health journeys.

Olivewood Gardens is located in National City on 7.85 acres of property. Over the past year Olivewood has increased our food production to meet the needs of the community during the challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic, and have maintained our program reach through pre-recorded and live virtual programs for kids, families, and adults. In 2020, we distributed over 6600 lbs of Olivewood grown produce at our weekly produce stand, and had over 30,0000 hits on our virtual programs.
